Children enjoyed dressing up in their favourite book characters. We also had a visit from Pam at Holt Book Shop and presented a free book for all the children.

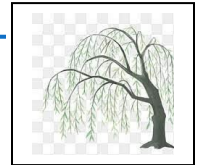


MAPLE CLASS

In Literacy in Willow class last week, children explored instructions and created their own Roman roads by using a variety of food ingredients to represent the different layers. This week, they have been busy preparing to be Roman Gladiators. They have enjoyed basic training at Gladiator school, role playing scenarios and will use this knowledge to write their own instructions in subsequent sessions.

In Science, children have explored vertebrates and invertebrates. They have classified vertebrates into five different groups (mammals, reptiles, amphibians, birds, fish) and have been very excited to use their knowledge to find invertebrates in the local, Kelling environment. We were very excited to find some vertebrates too... two newts and two frogs in our garden too!
