FOUNDING DAY

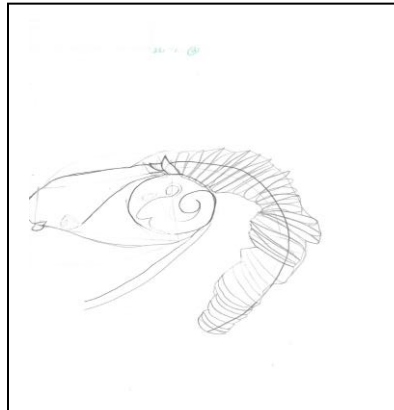
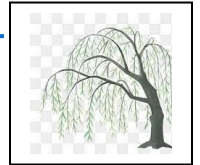
All children enjoyed their trip to Walsingham to celebrate Founding day with our other Federation schools.
